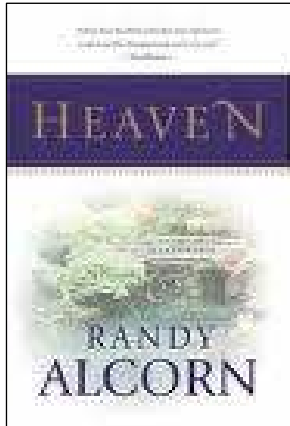

MEXICO MISSION TEAM PRESENTATION



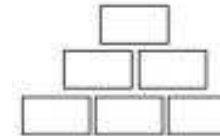
