Purpose

First Baptist Foundation is designed to encourage special gifts to the Church, particularly bequests and memorials. The income from this fund is made available for special purposes and needs of the Church.

Gifts received by the Foundation are considered "special gifts" and will be used to meet "special needs" of the Church. As special gifts, these funds also can be used to expand the Christian ministry of First Baptist Church in the community and to assist with the mission-related needs of our denomination in the U.S.A. and around the world.

History

After much research and study, the First Baptist Foundation was established by vote of the congregation in October, 1986, and duly incorporated in August, 1987. The first Board of Directors was elected in July, 1987. In January 1987, some of the existing money began to be transferred from the church accounts to the Foundation for management. The first contribution to the Foundation was received in October, 1988.
